
CASA: Advocates for Children of New York State AT A GLANCE

What is CASANYS?


CASA: Advocates for Children of New York State is a state-wide organization that works to provide volunteer advocates for children who have been abused and neglected.

Our goal is to help children find homes that are safe and permanent.

2010 Statistics:

- Local CASA Programs served an estimated 3,546 children.
- CASA volunteers numbered 905.
- Each CASA volunteer contributed, on average, approximately
 105 hours of time.
- The total number of hours contributed by CASA volunteers is 97,251.
- Total # of Cases: 1,935
- Total # of Cases closed: 1,228
